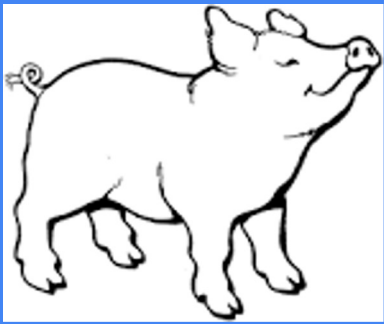


Figurative Language

Read the cards to learn about figurative language.

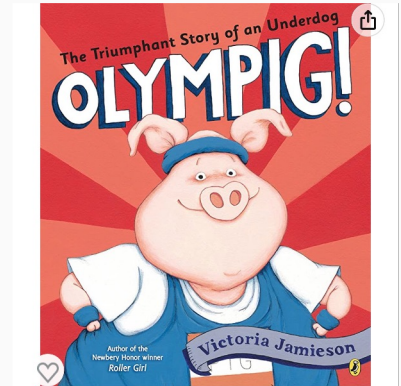


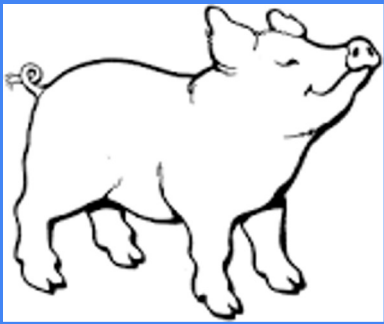


Let's Get Physical

Skip count by 2's, 5's or 10's.



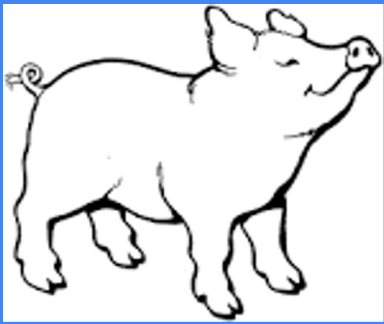


Estimation

Chose a pig to estimate the weight.

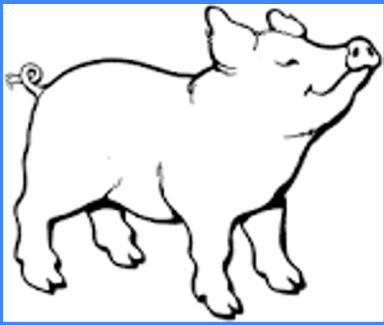




Balance
