




















Panning

Farmers decide what needs to be planted, where it needs to be planted, and how much needs to be planted. They also must determine how much supplies will be needed.

Planting

Farmers prepare the soil for planting by plowing. Farmers put plant seeds into the ground to grow crops for the year.

Growing

The seeds grow into plants. The plants grow. The farmers spray crops to prevent diseases and insects that can harm the plants. The farmer spends time observing the crops making sure there aren't any problems.

Harvesting

The farmer and his crew pick the vegetables.

Processing

This step is when the product is washed, sorted, and bagged, frozen, or canned. Or the product is changed into a different form by cutting or cooking, then is packaged.

Consumer

The consumer, you, use the food product. This can be at home or at a restaurant.
