The program is designed to encourage counties to support programs and activities in their local communities. Arkansas Farm Bureau supports ongoing efforts to build stronger communities throughout the state. This program is a great way to Make It Matter in your community.

Community Programs

Eligible programs include, but are not limited to:

- → Food Program- Backpack Program, Food Bank/Pantry donations
 - · Monetary and food/item donations are eligible
- → School Supply Drive
 - Monetary donations, school supply donations and/or gift card donations
- **→** Donations to local organizations
 - Monetary and item donations
 - Examples: Women's Shelter, The CALL, Senior Living Facilities, Animal Shelters, etc...
- → Hold or sponsor donation drives
 - Example: hold a Fill-A-Ford or similar drive, sponsor a diaper or personal hygiene supply drive at your county office and donate the collected items to a local shelter.
- → Partner with FFA and 4-H chapters or other youth organization on community projects.
 - Examples: Partner with a local youth organization for a reading program at a local school or library. Partner with a local youth organization for fair cleanup, prior to the fair.
